

FACTS TO KNOW

- The Paramedics that are participating in this Program are Lancaster EMS employees and are qualified to provide education. All Lancaster EMS employees submit to regular background checks.
- Please schedule appointments at least three weeks in advance.
- Those receiving our New Parent Program education will receive a Heartsaver CPR certification card in the mail about three weeks after their visit.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



*SIDS Education:

Sudden Infant Death Syndrome is a tragic experience for any parent. Our Paramedics will educate parents on reducing the risk of SIDS. This education will also address infant safe sleeping practices.

*Heartsaver CPR/Child & Infant Choking:

Our certified Paramedic educators will train and certify parent(s) in performing Heartsaver CPR on adults, children and infants and how to help a child or infant who is choking. The parent(s) will receive a Heartsaver CPR book and an AHA Friends and Family Infant Manikin (while supplies last).

*Shaken Baby Education:

Our Paramedics will provide education about "Shaken Baby Syndrome" prevention, as well as valuable resource material for the parents and other caregivers. They will also discuss caregiver factors that may lead to increased risk of shaken baby syndrome. Prevention and the signs and symptoms of shaken baby syndrome will also be reviewed.

*Febrile (fever) Seizure Education:

Our Paramedics will provide education about febrile seizures and how a parent should respond when an infant is having a seizure. This type of medical emergency may sometimes require assistance from emergency medical personnel. Our Paramedics will discuss general information about when to call for an ambulance.

• Each New Parent Program is catered to your individual needs. The program generally lasts about two hours.

Cost is \$135 (includes all educational material).
